Conditions of Participation:

1. Advance Registration is required. Dues will be waived for returning members who were registered in 2021. Only new registrants will be required to pay dues. Dues are waived for all students and any other members who request a waiver. There is no set amount for dues, but we recommend \$100 per year. Donations are always welcome. Dues and donations are fully tax deductible per our nonprofit status (EIN 82-3214753).
2. Proof of full vaccination and booster shot is required at the door, or in advance with your registration.
3. Masks must be worn whenever possible.
4. Physical distancing of a minimum of 6 feet for all individuals with masks, and a minimum of 12 feet for wind instrument players. If wind instrument players have covers for their instruments to prevent transmission of airborne water droplets and particulates, we ask that they be used.
5. We will resume rehearsals with the music we were working on in July of 2021, so many players will still have that music. If you do not have the sheet music already, please contact Susan (707-768-1975) ASAP to get your copy.
6. The rehearsal hall may be cold because we will rehearse with doors and windows open.
7. No snacks or drinks will be provided. If you need to eat or drink during a 2 hour rehearsal, bring your own. That includes water.
8. No spectators are allowed.
9. We are hopeful that we may be able to relax some of these conditions and restrictions eventually.
