Conditions of Participation:

- We ask you to commit to regular home practice of the music scheduled for performance by ASO, and to regular and prompt attendance at rehearsals and performances. Attendance will be taken and awards will be given for perfect attendance.
- 2. Registration is required by ALL participants.
- 3. Rehearsal time is most Saturdays from 10 a.m. to noon at the Eureka Woman's Club, 1531 J Street, Eureka, with occasional rehearsals during the academic year Wednesday at 7 p.m. at Fulkerson Recital Hall. Rehearsals will rarely start earlier or end later.
- 4. Dues are payable now for the fiscal year January to December. Dues are waived for all students and any other members who request a waiver. There is no set amount for dues, but we recommend \$100 per year. Donations are always welcome. Dues and donations are fully tax deductible per our nonprofit status (EIN 82-3214753). If you already paid dues for the Spring Set, you do not need to pay again.
